Dear Constituent,

On 23 June voters will be given the choice to leave, or remain in, the European Union. This could be one of the most important votes we cast in a generation.

Constituents have told me that they would like to better understand the arguments. I have therefore organised eight local debates during June which will feature local speakers who will argue for each side. I will chair these debates and will explain, with balance to both sides, what a reformed EU would look like should the nation vote to remain in the EU as well as the process for withdrawing should we vote to leave.

Many MPs are seeking to persuade their constituents to vote for one side or another. As your MP, I believe I will be of more help to you if I bring you the information and leave you to make your own decision. This is a referendum where our 45 million voters will decide the outcome, not 650 politicians. I hope that you will join me at one of the debates where you can hear the arguments and have your say.

Details of the debates are on the reverse of this letter. There is no need to register – it is first come, first seated. Please help me to promote the debates by putting the details in your window.
